

Personal data policy

The Nils Einar Grönberg foundation wishes to protect your personal integrity. We want you to feel safe when you share your data with us and that you trust that we process this data in a correct way. In this personal data policy we describe the handling of personal data, why we handle this data, how we collect it and how we use it. We will also describe who is in charge of handling this data and your rights concerning your data. The policy applies to you who use the foundations website <https://www.nilseinarfoundation.com> and the services which are linked to the website. We handle and process your personal data according to the current legislation concerning personal integrity, e.g the general data protection regulation (EU) 2016/679.

“Personal data” applies to the data that can be used in order to identify a physical living person.

Responsible for personal data

The Nils Einar Grönberg foundation, org.nr.802482-1866, is responsible for handling your personal data that the foundation stores

Our handling of your personal data

The Foundations registers and handles data about the persons with whom the Foundation have a relation to, that appears in photographs or other material that we publish, or people that we for other reasons need info about. Our aim is that none of your personal data shall be collected, stored or handled in vain. Therefore we only handle personal data when it's necessary.

Personal data that we collect

The personal data we handle about you is the data that you voluntarily share with us, for example your email, when you send material to us or register for newsletters. The data that we then handle will be your name, address, email and phone number. For applications regarding financial support and scholarships we will need the name of your project and the beneficiary account. Organisations that apply for support will need to share organisational number, person of contact, address, email address phone numbers and beneficiary account. We also handle pictures, films and audio and other information about the projects which the Foundation supports and works with.

Purpose of the handling of personal data en legal basis

We process and use the personal data we collect from you so that we can communicate with you, send newsletters and invitations to events and possibly other purposes, such as information regarding scholarships or project support, to which you have given your consent.

We also process personal data to:

1. administer and manage project support or scholarships according to the Foundation's statutes. The processing also relates to payments, follow-ups, and reports.
2. provide service and answer inquiries about the Foundation's operations
3. inform about the Foundation's operations, activities and collaborations
4. carry out internal administration purposes, internal statistics and evaluation, development and improvement of the Foundation's operations
5. conduct surveys and collect information for statistical purposes.
6. fulfill the Foundation's obligations according to applicable laws, regulations and authority decisions. When you have consented to the processing of your personal data, for example publication of images, films and sound recordings, your consent is the legal basis for processing this data. You can withdraw your consent at any time. For other processing, the legal basis is the foundation's legitimate interest. The processing is

necessary so that the Foundation can, for example, administer the granting of project support and scholarships, provide service, evaluate, improve and inform about the Foundation's activities. It also includes the actions that the Foundation performs regarding troubleshooting, protection, testing and improvement of systems that the Foundation uses in its operations. When personal data is processed in order to be able to fulfill obligations according to applicable laws, regulations and authority decisions, for example according to the Accounting Act or tax laws, legal obligation is the legal basis for the processing. Where your personal data is processed

Your personal data is processed within the EU/EEA. If it becomes necessary to transfer your data to a country outside the EU/EEA, we will inform you of this in advance.

Sharing of your personal data

Your personal data is processed as a starting point only with us. Your data may under certain circumstances be disclosed and shared with other external actors or so-called personal data assistants, for example our bank for administration of deposits and withdrawals, authorities according to law: including the County Administrative Board, the foundation's auditors, and providers of data services in connection with IT development, operation and technical support. We may also need to give suppliers and subcontractors access to your personal data when they perform services on our behalf, for example in connection with registration for events.

Information regarding storage time

We save your personal data as long as the data is needed to fulfil the above-mentioned purposes and as long as we have a business-related reason to contact you. The data can also be saved for the time required by applicable law. Personal data is anonymized when it is no longer relevant for purposes for which it was collected. You have the option to unsubscribe from receiving newsletters and other information from us. If you choose to unregister, we will stop processing your personal data for these purposes and delete your personal data in our contact information.

Personal data security

We take necessary and appropriate technical and organizational security measures to protect your personal data. The measures are taken to prevent unauthorized persons from gaining access to the data. At the Foundation, only the information that is needed is handled and only by the people who need it.

Your rights

You have the right to receive information from us about which personal data we process about you and, upon request, receive a copy of them. You also have the right to have incorrect personal data about you corrected and in some cases deleted. You can also object to the processing of certain personal data about you and request that the processing be restricted. Under certain conditions, you also have the right to obtain personal data about you in a machine-readable format and to have the data transferred to another party responsible for personal data. You are not obliged to provide us with personal data. If you choose not to provide us with personal data or limit our right to process your data, this may mean that we cannot, for example, send you newsletters or other information. If you are dissatisfied with how we process your personal data, you have the right to lodge a complaint with The Swedish Privacy Protection Agency (IMY), which supervises foundations' processing of personal data.
